Our study of “Gospel in Life” has been challenging as we look at the hidden motives behind the things we do. Here is what we have covered so far:

Week One

God’s plan for the city is to be a place of refuge and safety, justice, culture development, and spiritual seeking and finding. God’s people are not to separate themselves from the city but are to work for the good and prosperity of the city while keeping their spiritual identity.

Week Two

The natural intent of the human heart is to turn to self, even when doing good. We need to not only repent of the bad things we do, but the reasons behind the good things we do.

Week Three

Our idols are the desires we have that have become preeminent in our lives. Sin is the result of something being more important at that moment than God-an idol.

Week Four

We will not know God, change deeply, or win the world apart from community.

Week Five

Jesus says we are to be a city on a hill (Mathew 5:14). In other words, we are to be a different type of community-gospel speaking, neighbor loving, and spirit transformed- so that our neighbors are attracted to Jesus.
